- Conduct or character certificate/reference letter from the school/college on letter head.
- Attach one JPEG photo in online application form & submit 5 hard copy photos (passport-size) during admission.
- One copy of passport along with residence visa (wherever applicable)
- Copy of TOEFL / IELTS scores.
- Copy of Equivalency Certificate (for students who studied foreign curriculum in UAE)

For RN-BSN Program

- Diploma & mark sheet copy (All 3 years)
- Copy of IELTS/TOEFL score
- RN license /MOH license copy
- Copy of Certificate of showing proof of work experience of 2 years or more.
- Attach one JPEG photo in online application form & submit 5 hard copy photos (passport-size) during admission
- One copy of passport along with residence visa (wherever applicable)
- Copy of Equivalency certificate (for students who studied Diploma in Nursing outside UAE)

For Masters Program

- Copy of Bachelor degree and mark sheet detailed of 4 years.
- Copy of IELTS/TOEFL score
- Copy of Certificate of showing proof of work experience of 2 years or more.
- Attach one JPEG photo in online application form & submit 5 hard copy photos (passport-size) during admission.
- One copy of passport along with residence visa (wherever applicable)
- Copy of Equivalency certificate (for students who studied Bachelor degree outside UAE)

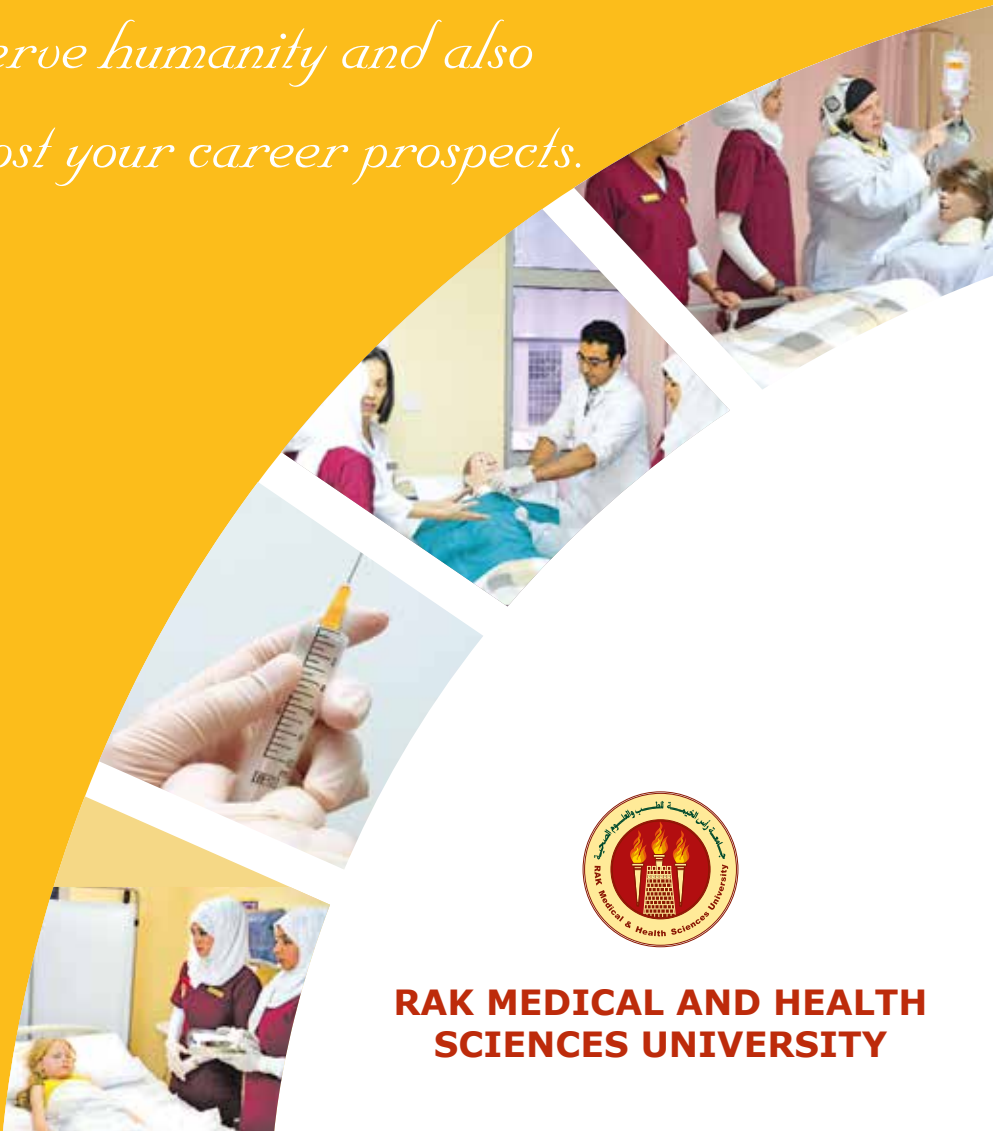

Student life and campus facilities

At RAKMHSU, you will find a full fledged library and lecture halls, high-tech state-of-the-art nursing skill laboratories, IT resources and computer services, academic advising and counselling services, separate semi-furnished residential facility for male and female students, a gym and sports facilities. Student Visa is also provided.

How to get in-admission criteria for BSN

UAE NGSSSE:

Aggregate of 70% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in 12th Grade with minimum of 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology individually.

Pakistan Boards/Certificates:

Higher Secondary School Certificate with aggregate of 65% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Part 1 and Part 2 total) with minimum 60% in each of these courses.

Indian Boards/Certificates:

CBSE XII Std with 65% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Biology with at least 60% in each of these courses.

For Indian State Board Examination, 70% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Biology with at least 60% in each of these courses is required.

For other curriculum, equivalencies corresponding to UAE NGSSSE apply, refer website.

Conversion Program leading to BSN (for UAE Nationals sponsored by MOH):

Based on the agreement signed by Ministry of Health and RAK MHSU, UAE Nationals who have completed arts/commerce stream of UAE NGSSSE/12th grade with 75% or above aggregate can apply to Ministry of Health (MOH) for sponsorship to join Conversion Program within the dates mentioned by them.

MOH will provide the final list of the students selected for sponsorship to RAK MHSU.

The duration of the Conversion Program is 16 weeks. Upon passing the Conversion Program with a GPA of 2, and upon meeting the English Language requirements (IELTS with a score of 5 or TOEFL paper based test with a score of 500), students will be eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree program.

UAE Nationals from science stream who fulfill all the requirements for the BSN program at RAK MHSU may directly approach MOH for sponsorship.

UAE Nationals applying for RN-BSN & Masters may directly check with MOH regarding their scholarship suitability once they qualify for admission.

RN-BSN Bridge Program

Registered nurses who have completed Diploma in Nursing from an accredited school of nursing with 70% aggregate in Diploma in Nursing with 2 years of clinical working experience (OR with 65%-69% in Diploma in Nursing with 3-7 years of clinical working experience) and RN licensure from the country of origin can apply.

Proficiency in English equivalent to a TOEFL score of 500 in paper-based test, 61 in internet-based test, 173 in computer based test, Academic IELTS score of 5 or Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE) score of 41 or Pearson Test of English Academic (PTEA) score range of 36-41 is mandatory for entry to undergraduate programs.

Master of Science in Nursing (MSN)

Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree with minimum CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent. Minimum 2 years of clinical experience in the area of speciality and RN licensure from the country of origin.

Proficiency in English equivalent to a TOEFL score of 550 in paper-based test, 79 in internet-based test, 213 in computer based test, Academic IELTS score of 6 or Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE) score of 52 Pearson Test of English Academic (PTEA) score range of 50-57 is mandatory for entry to graduate programs.

Admission is purely based on merit and open to students of all nationalities.

Fees are for the academic year 2016-2017 and payable semester wise. There are 2 semesters in an academic year.

Late registration fee: Fees are to be paid within in the deadlines given prior to commencement of the new semester. Late Registration fee of AED 500 will be charged if fees are not paid latest by the first day of the new semester.

Health Insurance card is mandatory for all students. RN-BSN Students should have a valid health insurance card from the government or should be adequately covered under a health insurance by a current employer.

Students will be required to buy on their own the instruments, personal protective gear including uniforms, masks, gloves etc. as per each program requirement.

Refund Policy Requests for refund should be made at the Office of Admission & Registration by submitting a written

request of withdrawal/e-mail along with original fee receipt. Refund will be made only after clearance of all dues, if any, to the University.

A refund claim shall be submitted to the office of Registration. On approval, the amount shall be refunded as mentioned below.

Refund of Transport Fee Students who decide not to avail the bus facility within two weeks from the date of commencement of classes will be refunded 50% of the transport fee. Beyond 2 weeks, the total fee paid is non-refundable. The refund policy applies to all semesters.
